The County Innovator of the Year is to recognize those individuals from each of the affiliates who developed a unique process, cost saving activity, constituent friendly environment, etc... that other Counties wish to duplicate. The innovation is not intended to be “*pigeon holed*” in the provided examples as ones imagination can’t be limited. The positive impact of an innovation does not have to be limited to clients but can be something for Department employees, or vendors.

The litmus test is: What makes this unique, does it have a positive impact on the community, how improvements are measured, and is it a positive reflection of the nominee’s County. This creates an endless scope of possibilities both big and small.

Each of the innovators nominated from the affiliates will be recognized at the Fall Conference. Of the nominees one will be selected as the IACO County Innovator of the Year. The following guidelines need to be followed by each affiliate making nominations.

- 1) Nominees must be a currently serving County Official.
- 2) Affiliate nomination(s) must be presented to the Affiliate President on the form provided.
  - a. Individuals are free to nominate his/her self.
  - b. Members of other affiliates are free to nominate persons from other IACO member affiliates within their County, for example, the ‘X’ County Treasurer can nominate the ‘X’ County Auditor and send the nomination to the President of the Auditors Association.
- 3) A maximum of one (1) nominee will be presented to the IACO Awards Committee from each affiliate President.
- 4) The affiliate nomination must be **received by** the IACO Awards Committee no later than 4:30pm October 23, 2015.
